

## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

The Barnstable Fire District (“Owner”) shall receive sealed bids at the Barnstable Fire District Water Department, 1841 Phinney’s Lane, P.O. Box 546, Barnstable Massachusetts, 02630 for the construction of water distribution system valve replacements on Main Street (Route 6A) at Railroad Avenue, Millway Road, Braggs Lane, and Commerce Road, and Mary Dunn Road, Contract No. 2019-02, until 2:00 PM prevailing time, Thursday, November 15, 2018, at which time bids will be opened and publicly read aloud. Bids submitted after this time will not be accepted.

The Work generally consists of the furnishing and installing of water distribution system valve replacements at the following locations on Main Street (Route 6A); Railroad Avenue (3 valves), Millway Road (5 valves), Braggs Lane (1 valve) Commerce Road (3 valves), and Mary Dunn Road (1 valve). Work located in the area of Braggs Lane, Commerce Road and Mary Dunn Road are subject to the requirements of a Massachusetts Department of Transportation Highway Access Permit, which is pending.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a bid security in the amount of 5% of the total bid amount and in the form described in the Instructions to Bidders. A Performance Bond and Labor and Materials Payment Bond, each in the amount of 100 percent of the Contract Price, will be required in the form described in the Instructions to Bidders.

The bidding and award of the Contract will be under the provisions of “Massachusetts General Law, Chapter 30, Section 39M (MGL C.30, S.39M).” Minimum Wage Rates as determined by the Commissioner of Department of Workforce Development under the provision of the Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 149, Sections 26 to 27D, as amended, apply to this project. It is the responsibility of the bidder, before bid opening, to request if necessary, any additional information on Minimum Wage Rates for those trades people and additional classifications who may be employed for the proposed work under this contract.

This Contract contains price adjustments for hot mix asphalt, diesel fuel, gasoline, and Portland cement concrete. For this project the base prices are as follows: liquid asphalt \$550.00 per ton, diesel fuel \$2.673 per gallon, gasoline \$2.386 per gallon, and Portland cement \$128.00 per ton.
