## IMPORTANT NOTICE

### WATER SERVICE INTERRUPTIONS APRIL 15<sup>TH</sup> TO MAY 22<sup>ND</sup> 2019

*Dear Valued Customers of the Barnstable Fire District Water Department:*

**Please expect water service interruptions along Route 6A as intersections are isolated from the water system in order to replace gate valves and sections of water mains. The work will be conducted at the intersections of Railroad Avenue, Millway/Hyannis Road, Braggs Lane, Commerce Road, and Mary Dunn Road.**

Please be advised that the Water Department will be replacing water main gate valves along Route 6A from the intersection on Railroad Avenue to Mary Dunn Road during the coming weeks. This work will be conducted between the hours of 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM Monday through Friday, excluding holidays. The work will require night work in the area of Railroad Avenue for two evenings during the last two weeks of April. The gate replacements are due to the age of the water system, and several gates will no longer operate.

The following list of roads will be affected by water service interruptions for a day or two:

Route 6A from Rendezvous Lane to Winsor Way, including Railroad Avenue and Windsor Way.

Route 6A from Windsor Way to Braggs Lane.

Route 6A from Braggs Lane to Mary Dunn Road, including County Farm, Redwing Lane, Cindy Lane, Captain Murphy's, and Adrien Way.

Millway Road from #35 to #164, and all of Freezer Road.

Hyannis Road to Hyannis Road.

Commerce Road from #312 to #428.

Indian Tail, Indian Hill, and Wild Rose Lane.

**The Water Department will notify residents by phone the day before their neighborhood's service interruption.**

**Residents can expect discolored water during the project, especially following a shut down. When your water service is restored, please run an outside faucet or cold water tub spout to ensure that your water is clear before using to avoid staining of laundry, appliances or plumbing fixtures.** Every effort will be made to limit inconvenience to you during construction, but as with any project of this nature, you can expect delays traveling through the work areas along Route 6A, and you should plan according to seek alternate routes. Please advise your children to stay away from the construction area. Playing on construction equipment or stored materials in the construction area can be dangerous.

All work areas disturbed during this work will be restored at the completion of the project.
