Greetings,

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby requested to notify the inhabitants of the Barnstable Fire District who are qualified to vote to meet at Barnstable County Offices, Old Jail Building, East Wing Conference Room, Barnstable County Complex, 3195 Main Street, Barnstable, MA on Wednesday, September 23, 2020, at 7:30 p.m. then and there to act on the following articles:

- Article 1:** To see if the District will vote to accept the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Fire Fighters Grant (AFG) under the Staffing for Adequate Fire and Emergency Response (SAFER) program in the amount of \$305,225.88 to hire one (1) additional Firefighter/Paramedic in the Barnstable Fire Department for a three years period. Said funds to be expended by the Fire Chief with the approval of the Prudential Committee.
- Article 2:** To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or borrow and appropriate the sum of \$18,220.00 for pre-employment examinations, background checks, uniforms and turnout gear, and Recruit Training expenses for the hiring of one (1) additional Firefighter/Paramedic in the Barnstable Fire Department. Said funds to be expended by the Fire Chief with the approval of the Prudential Committee.
- Article 3:** To see if the District will vote to accept the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG) under the Equipment/Vehicle program in the amount of \$761,904.76 to be used to purchase and equip a \$1,320,000.00 new NFPA 1901 compliant Quint fire apparatus for the Barnstable Fire Department. Said funds to be expended by the Fire Chief with the approval of the Prudential Committee.
- Article 4:** To see if the District will vote to raise and appropriate and/or borrow and appropriate the sum of \$558,095.24 to be used to the purchase and equip a \$1,320,000.00 new NFPA 1901 compliant Quint fire apparatus Barnstable Fire Department and dispose of a 1991 Pierce Arrow aerial ladder truck in the best interest of the Barnstable Fire District. Said funds to be expended by the Fire Chief with the approval of the Prudential Committee.

You are hereby directed to serve this warrant by publishing it in the Cape Cod Times and by posting attested copies thereof at the office of the District, 1841 Phinney's Lane, Barnstable Village and the Fire Station, 3249 Main Street, Barnstable Village and filing the Warrant with the Town Clerk in accordance with MGL c. 30A, s. 20:
