RELOCATION OF THE SCADA SYSTEM

- Steve Rizzo discussed two different options.
 - 1. Relocating the existing Scada System and getting it working in new location is \$8,100.00
 - 2. Relocating the existing Scada and then upgrading it will be \$8,100.00 plus \$45,900.00 (upgrading includes new electronics, software and computer)
