BOARD OF WATER COMMISSIONERS SPECIAL MEETING

February 28, 2024, at the Water Department office

PRESENT WERE: Board of Water Commissioners, Chairman Mason and Commissioner Stephen Whitmore and Commissioner Evelyn Bassett. Also present: Superintendent Sean Anderson, Assistant Superintendent Ron Tivey and Service Man I Scott Heaslip.

Meeting called to order at 2:30 PM

FISCAL YEAR 2025 ANNUAL BUDGET

- Superintendent Anderson suggested a 14% increase in pay for everyone since the new hire will be making more money than the job was posted for. We need to be competitive with the market.
- Collector, Kim Vermette granted sick time buy out due to retiring in July.
- Superintendent Anderson suggested increasing from \$275.00 to \$350.00 for the Service Man on-call.
- Commissioner Bassett questions stand-by pay rate. Superintendent Anderson said stand-by is a set rate per week to be on call for the week as well as any over-time past working 40 hours.
- Superintendent Anderson suggested that when we bring gas to our new treatment building, bring it to our existing facilities and generators as well.
- Repair maintenance.
- Commissioner Whitmore made a **motion to accept** the fiscal budget. **Seconded** by Commissioner Bassett and **passed unanimously.**

WATER BALANCE PROGRAM

- An exemption for any single-family house meant for subdivisions and commercial.
- Every gallon of water you use you will find a gallon of water of savings in our system.
- The Water Balance Program will conserve money and water.
- If you don't you will pay a litigation fee which will be about 10.00 per gallon per day.
- Commissioner Whitmore moves to approve the water balance program and the review of the policy revision that is going to incorporate the water balance program. Commissioner Bassett seconded the motion and passed unanimously.

CAPITAL PROJECTS UPDATE

- The town council president sent out an email requesting attendance from someone from the Board of Water Commissioners to do a presentation on what measures are being down to secure water and the future water supply.
- The board and Superintendent agreed it was not enough time to put something like this together and they were asking for a lot of information.
- Loan forgiveness of 31.6% it equals over 2.2 million dollars which will bring cost of project down.
- New Treatment Update: Code changed as of December 2023. Requiring a bathroom
- Sanitary Survey 2/29/24

TIME OFF POLICY – PARENTAL LEAVE

- Job security when out for parental leave.
- Board approved Service Man I Scott using sick time to cover his parental leave.

SERVICE TECHNICIAN II – OPEN POSITION – WILLIAM THEURET

- Commissioner Whitmore **motioned** to hire William Theuret at \$28.50 per hour **seconded** by Chairman Mason and **passed unanimously.**
- Superintendent recommended 2 weeks at the hire of the position and after a year of employment will get 3 weeks.
- Superintendent will reach out verbally to make an offer to William Theuret and ask for Cori and physical.

Chairman Mason **motioned** to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned at 3:40p.m.
